

#### **Creative Outreach**

Campus ministry has natural cycles and rhythms, which means that we are already wrapping up the semester with our college students and beginning to evaluate the past few months in order to plan for the spring. This semester has required us to think in new ways about how to reach students. One way our team tried to innovate was through campus outreach. Though we could not use any indoor university space for meetings, we could continue to meet students outdoors. On weeks when the weather was nice, Caleb and other staff from Cru would set up a table or bring a couple of lawn chairs and a sign that said "Conversation for a TastyKake" or a board with pictures that can be used for interacting over a person's spiritual journey. Students who approached the table were genuinely interested in engaging on spiritual topics. These times of outreach have proved fruitful, as students are openly willing to talk during weeks and months of uncertainty.

This month, Caleb met with several staff from other areas of our region to brainstorm more ideas for how to effectively outreach on the college campus during COVID. We are not experts in how to reach people for Christ in the midst of a pandemic! But God is faithful and is teaching us to patiently follow His lead. We have been encouraged by the willingness of our student leaders to step out in faith and try new ideas as well.
