



Mark Your Calendar for our Lenten Group Study!





Upon return, the Temple students have been eagerly planning for the new semester, and they have 18 people signed up for their weekly Bible study. We are pursuing a new chapter of Design at Drexel University with a student who attended the conference. God is at work in this community, and we are blessed to play a small role.

We had a great group of students from Penn, Temple, and even Bowling Green University in Ohio join us for an MLK Day of Service at Kirkbride School. They helped us clean classrooms, give away donated clothing to the community, and sweep up glass from the streets surrounding the rowhome fire. We are so encouraged that students are catching the vision for serving the city while in college as we continue to provide them with opportunities.


Sanctuary Flowers
