## Vance Church Welcomes Harmony House

It's officially 2020 and so has begun a new chapter in the life of Vance Memorial Presbyterian Church.

Vance Church now welcomes Harmony House to the third floor where it will utilize space for three offices, two waiting rooms, and a video/audio space for interviewing children in preparation for court procedures. Harmony House is a comprehensive children's advocacy organization that works to assist children and developmentally disabled adults who have been abused or neglected and works to prevent the victimization of those same individuals.

"I am thrilled that Harmony House will be at Vance. They took care of [my adopted granddaughter] back when she was removed from her mom. I was taking [her] to therapy there for several months. They do great work there for children. Thank the [Vance] Elders for me," said one local Presbyterian grandmother upon learning of this new arrangement.

Vance has been searching for the right tenant for its third floor since before the arrival of Senior Pastor Erica Harley a year and a half ago. Nearly 3000 square feet was virtually unused in the Vance Christian Education wing. "We needed a group with an affinity to our other third floor renters, Young Life and Junior League," said Harley.

When Harmony House lost its offices with the closing of OVMC, a perfect situation presented itself. "This seems win-win for all involved," Harley continued. "Harmony House needed appropriate office space; Vance needed space utilized by a community organization."

Harley also emphasized that this new partnership is part of a greater comprehensive vision for Vance Church to serve the greater Wheeling community with its resources. "We anticipate doing great things together for the children of our community," Harley concluded.

# Stewardship is heart work
