

Tutoring resumed at Kirkbride School this month after a hiatus for the Winter holidays. Many of the usual volunteers returned for another semester, but a few were unable to commit to the Spring session. Because of this, I (Claire) decided to focus our efforts on the older students who struggle with basic reading skills. I asked for teacher input on which students would be best suited for the program, and several teachers gave great recommendations and even talked to parents directly about enrolling in the after school program. I've had direct contact with a handful of teachers as they give me resources and direction for how to best help each individual student. It is truly a partnership, and I am grateful for the years of investing that have led to such close working relationships!

We have exciting projects on the horizon. Caleb will be taking a group of students to Rutgers University for a couple days in the beginning of March, and Claire will spend a week in Denver in mid-March helping to lead a refugee focused Spring Break trip for students and other Cru staff.
