Hi everyone. My name is Diane and I'm a grateful believer of Jesus Christ. I celebrate recovery from people pleasing, codependency and childhood trauma but still struggle with social anxiety & depression. If you've ever attended a Celebrate Recovery (CR) meeting then you have heard similar introductions. If you've not been to CR then that introduction may sound a little strange to you. I remember when I first went to CR over ten years ago, I first thought that introduction was odd as well, so I get it. But I've since learned, it's freeing to call out what I'm needing help with, and sharing what God has helped me conquer.

I understand that most don't understand what CR is. My first time at CR I honestly didn't get it either. I went simply to appease a friend who was repeatedly asking me if I would attend with her. I went assuming I was supporting her, but what I wasn't expecting was it's exactly what I needed too. Hearing others' stories, being part of the fellowship and worship of CR - it was therapeutic to me and helped me begin facing the hurts habits and hang ups I'd been trying to avoid facing for years. years I told myself I'm good. I had issues but convinced myself that it was nothing that I needed to go to CR for. But that was me simply allowing fear to rule me. Yes fear. Fear of admitting I needed help. Fear of facing my hurts habits and hang ups. Fear of taking a good long look at myself kept me away. But God gently showed me that fear alone only ensures I remain isolated. And at the time I did feel so alone and isolated. Society has convinced us that there's shame in sharing our issues. But that's the furthest from the truth. We are one body and we're to be there for one another. 1 Corinthians 12:26-27 says "If one part suffers, every part suffers with it. If one part is honored, every part shares in its joy. You are the body of Christ. Each one of you is a part of it." Friends, we're all broken and dealing with hurts habits and hang

ups. So I'm glad my friend convinced me to go to CR and I'm glad God has helped me through CR to conquer many of my hurts, habits and hangups. At CR, we are a "forever family". We are there to support each other in the dark times and celebrate with each other in the good times. We all need extra support in life. So I invite you to join us Thursday night at 6:30 pm in the Merrimen Chapel. Come see for yourself what CR is and allow God to do amazing things in your life.
