#### **Bid Me Follow**

I (Claire) often begin my mornings with a liturgy book called Every Moment Holy by Douglas McKelvey. One of the prayers that I commonly pray is A Liturgy for First Waking. I find the words timely each time I read them: "Nothing is too hard for you, Lord Christ. I deposit now all confidence in you that whatever these waking hours bring, my foundations will not be shaken. At day's end I will lay me down again to sleep knowing that my best hope is well kept in you. In all things your grace will sustain me. Bid me follow, and I will follow."

I take comfort in these words, that though we do not know what each day will hold, God remains in control and His wise plans will reign even in the midst of uncertain times. This semester has been full of ups and downs, but we sense God's care and direction nonetheless. We have conducted two virtual Fall Retreats, one for our Philly students within Cru movements city-wide, and one for our South Asian American students involved with Design. Though this was not the way we prefer our Fall Retreat to be held, God used this time to provide community, fellowship, and training for many who would otherwise not have been able to participate.

Our tutoring program at Christ Church has been a blessing both to our volunteers and students. The in-person atmosphere is enjoyed by everyone and each child is receiving individual attention to complete school assignments or practice reading skills. We are so grateful for church members who have given their time and are excited to help mobilize more people to meet the needs of our diverse community.
