

Janet Hart's Prize-Winning Chili Recipe

2 lbs ground round 1 cup chopped onion 1 cup chopped green pepper 2 large cans (29 oz) tomato sauce one 11 oz can tomato juice 2 tsp chili powder ½ tsp salt 2 cans (16 oz) navy beans, drained 1 can (16 oz) black beans, drained





Chase Burdick, "Celebrity" Chili Judge samples all the entries for the Chili Contest at the January Vespers while Erica supervises.

Brown the ground round in a large pot in a

little bit of oil. After starting to brown, add the onion and green pepper. Stir and cook until the vegetables are tender and the meat is browned.

Add the canned tomato ingredients, the drained beans and the seasonings. Stir well and simmer, covered, 45 minutes. Add ½ cup water if needed. Adjust seasonings to your taste if necessary. Serve with Cheddar cheese and nacho chips.

Caleb traveled to Columbus, Ohio, in mid-January for Design Movement Student Winter Conference. This year, the conference went from Friday night through Monday morning. The extended weekend allowed for speakers, worship, an afternoon outreach, seminars, a talent show, a heritage night to celebrate South Asian American culture, and much more. It was the largest Design Conference ever, with 106 total attendees, 10 of them coming from Philadelphia!

The theme of the conference, Called Out, came from 1 Peter 2:9, which says: "But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of Him who *called you out* of darkness into His wonderful light." Staff prayed that students would begin to think through what God might be calling them out of and inviting them into. Each person who has decided to follow Jesus has a calling that God has placed on their life; but sometimes obstacles and roadblocks, like pressure, time, idolatry, and other things keep us from stepping into our calling and relationship with God and others. The weekend was a time for students to consider how they are being called out and take steps toward walking in the light of who God has made them to be.
