Kidz Morning Out to the Minions Movie



OUR MISSIONARIES

South Africa Winter

We arrived in South Africa on June 21 after two overnight flights and a 12 hour layover in Zurich, Switzerland. Our team joined us several hours later directly from New Jersey. We spent our first week in the country getting to know each other and learning some South African history, customs, and favorite foods. We visited a monument depicting the history of the country before apartheid and will soon visit the Apartheid Museum in Johannesburg as well as the Freedom monument for a full picture of South African history. We all enjoyed a hike in a wildlife reserve and walked with an ostrich to a waterfall!

The tutoring program, The Mamelodi Initiative, began during our second week in country. We are helping eighth to twelfth graders practice English and Math during the Winter holiday from school. In the afternoons, we have fun workshops like knitting, yoga, Bible study, drama, and arts and crafts. Our team has been encouraged to see God at work in this village where many students do not speak English and come from extreme poverty.

We return from South Africa on July 18. Pray for good team relationships and for God to be glorified in our words and deeds as we serve and love the students of Mamelodi.
