

Mission Outreach and Community Service Commission NEWS

Beginning in 2021, the Mission Outreach and Community Service Commission (MOCS) chose to focus its mission on local food insecurity issues. To that end, the Commission donated \$6000 to Ohio Valley Family Services, an organization that serves over 100,000 meals to those is need in the Northern Panhandle. MOCS also gave \$1300 to YSS for an industrial food processor to serve meals to those in youth detention and group homes. Somewhere throughout the year, however, the focus of the Commission changed a bit to KIDS. With the knowledge that because of the pandemic "Kids have had a hard year," MOCS gave to the Troop #6 Scouts, Ohio Valley Young Life and most recently to the Madison Elementary School Playground Project. In fact, Vance Church will donate a large portion of the climbing equipment for the new trauma-informed playground. Remember that all this good work is made possible by YOUR Mission Commission and YOUR financial contributions. Vance Church is contributing mightily to our community. Earlier in May, Claire was part of a huge endeavor with Kirkbride School (where Lydia and Elena attend) for their annual fundraiser. This year, the Home and School Association decided to make a socially distant outdoor community event that involved students' families. We served ethnically diverse food, had games and raffle prizes, and raised money through a mystery auction for a new soccer pitch in the school yard. It was a radically different event from past fundraisers, but it has served to create more positive momentum in parents' trust of the HSA and we hope will bless our community for years to come.

Currently, we are in the middle of Summer Mission with Cru, right here in Philadelphia. Rather than traveling overseas this summer, we chose to remain local and host a group of students and staff in our own city. Claire is in charge of the financial details of the mission, while Caleb is preparing for Team Leader Training for his new role with the South Asian American ministry, Design, that he will transition to this summer.

The Summer Mission has been involved in many facets of urban ministry during their three-week project. They have beautified garden spaces, cleaned up an abandoned lot for a church in Center City, served food to those experiencing homelessness, traveled to Cru's humanitarian aid facility in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, helped at a local public elementary school, and much more. The pace of the project is fast and full, but we enjoy having our family participate in many of the events together with the students.
