



Caleb traveled to Atlanta, Georgia, and Columbia, South Carolina, where he met with a Central Asian staff member from Kingdom Rain for planning and caught up with supporters and old friends there. He came home encouraged at the blessing of relationships, even when time and distance separate. We are already planning another trip to South Carolina this summer to speak at a church we called home while language learning in 2010 and 2012.

After months of meeting together virtually, we love to serve together!
